

Showing In Hand/Ridden

- A video of an individual show can be ridden on any surface as long as it is safe for rider and horse to be used. This includes dressage arenas and open spaces.
- All ridden showing videos must be shown as indicated in our [demo video](#) (Halt sideways to the camera - 10m walk away from the camera - trot back towards the camera, directly followed by an individual show - this show should include a figure of eight in the trot, right and left rein canter (no canter for lead rein classes), a final halt sideways to the camera.
- For an in hand show, the handler will present the horse as follows: halt sideways to the camera - 10m walk away from the camera - trot back towards the camera - continue trotting in a large circle on the right rein and come to a final halt sideways to the camera. - Young horses must not be shown in a bitted bridle.
- We would like to encourage all riders/handlers to ride their horses/ponies in a snaffle, or even bitless.
